




This picture was taken **90 YEARS AGO** in 1932








Accident at work is a cost:		IN ITALY ACCIDENTS AT WORK COST			
DIRECT COST: as pre	mium	3-4% OF GDP			
INDIRECT COST: as <u>prevention</u> (training, safety devices) and as <u>costs that depend on the occurrence of the</u> <u>accident</u> (emergency aid, overtime, damage to machine)					

PREVENTION <u>reduces</u> the <u>frequency</u> and the <u>severity</u> of accidents at work **map** and <u>reduces</u> the cost of accidents at work too
